


# Model 276 Security Cart —Plating Assembly—



### ASSEMBLY - PLATING


**NOTE**: The cart, less plating, must be assembled prior to adding the plating. Instructions for assembling the cart are included in the shipping box for the cart.

- 1. Assemble the Cart, less plating, according to the assembly directions provided with the Cart.
- 2. Locate the four predrilled bolt holes in the side columns on the right side of the Cart as you are pushing it (See exploded view on page 5) and install four Carriage Bolts from the outside. You may need to use a hammer to get the bolts through the side column.
- 3. Insert the door plating to the inside of the side columns and line up the holes in the plating with the four carriage bolts.
- 4. Attach washer, lock washer and nut to all four Carriage Bolts and tighten. Ensure the door is functional.
- 5. Locate the four predrilled holes in the side columns on the rear of the Cart (See exploded view on page 5) and install four Carriage Bolts from the outside.
- 6. Insert the rear plating to the inside of the side columns and line up the holes in the plating with four Carriage Bolts.
- 7. Attach washer, lock washer and nut to all four Carriage Bolts and tighten.
- 8. Locate the four predrilled holes in the side columns on the front of the Cart (See exploded view page 5) and install four Carriage Bolts from the outside.
- 9. Insert the front plating to the inside of the side columns and line up the holes in the plating with the four Carriage Bolts.
- 10. Attach washer, lock washer and nut to all four Carriage Bolts and tighten.
- 11. Locate the remaining four predrilled holes in the side columns on the side opposite the door (See exploded view page 5) and install four Carriage Bolts from the outside.
- 12. Install the last side panel by opening the door and turning the side panel diagonally to fit through the door. Line up the holes in the plating with the four Carriage Bolts.
- 13. Attach washer, lock washer and nut to all four Carriage Bolts and tighten.
- 14. Install Rubber Grommet in the rear plating (See exploded view page 5)

Note: Plating is installed on the INSIDE of the side columns. See below for illustration.
